

## MEDIA STATEMENT

The NSW EPA issued a clean-up notice on 7th of December relating to material supplied during a period shortly after Wollongong Recycling (NSW) Pty Ltd was acquired. It is the same event as the previous EPA clean-up notice at Calderwood, and is not related to the release of any new contaminated materials.

This EPA notice specifically applies to the removal of material placed behind a number of retaining walls on that site.

To date all the above ground material at the Calderwood site has been removed in accordance with the previous clean-up notice to the satisfaction of the EPA.

Wollongong Recycling is working diligently with all parties, including the EPA, to expeditiously comply with the new clean-up notice issued.

The company's priority here is working closely with all parties to minimise any possible harm to the local community.

Wollongong Recycling operates in line with ISO 14001 standards including in respect of training for staff on its systems and processes.

Bingo Industries, the owner of Wollongong Recycling, does not expect the clean-up to have any material impact on FY18 earnings.
